



Week 5 – Being a disciple

1. Matthew 4: 19 – Jesus Calls the First Disciples

And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

2. John 21: 22 – Jesus and the Beloved Disciple

Jesus said to him, "If it is my will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? Follow me!"

3. John 6: 66 – 68 – The Words of Eternal Life

After this many of his disciples drew back and no longer walked with him. Jesus said to the Twelve, "Will you also go away? Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life; and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God."

4. Luke 11: 1- 4 – The Lord's Prayer

He was praying in a certain place, and when he ceased, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." And he said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread; and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive every one who is indebted to us; and lead us into the temptation."

5. Matthew 11: 29 – Jesus Thanks His Father

"Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."
