Do's for giving a testimony:

1. Pray to the Holy Spirit
2. Speak clearly and make eye contact
3. Tell your story naturally, from the heart, keep it simple
4. Focus is on God, and his work in your life
5. Be grateful for God's wonderful works in your life

Don'ts for giving a testimony:

1. Give a biography of your life
2. Use Catholic terminology
3. Be negative about other people or religious organisations
4. Focus on your pre-conversion sins
